Eligibility

One \$1,000 Genome BC scholarship is available to a student through the Science Fair Provincial Awards Program. The student must –

- Present their project at the senior age level (Grade 11 or 12) at a BC Regional Science Fair
- Be planning to enrol full-time in a science program upon graduation at a British Columbia post-secondary institution

To be considered for this scholarship, the student must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form
2. Current official transcript
3. Reference Letter from a teacher
4. Résumé/CV
5. Photo of the student with a short testimonial about the value of Genome BC's scholarship toward her/his career choice

Applications will be evaluated based on good academic standing and noteworthy achievements as shown in the application and attachments.
