## What Judges Want to Know From Your 3-5 Minute Video Presentation

- 1 What is your name, grade, and what region do you live in?
- 2 What is the title of your project?
- 3 What is the purpose of your project? What were you hoping to learn?
- 4 What made you interested in this topic? What made you start this project?
- 5 Explain what you did to learn about your topic. What steps did you take?
- 6 Show your results (through charts, graphs, logbooks, etc). Why are these results important?
- 7 List your conclusions. What did you learn? Did you come across anything unexpected during your project?
- 8 What might you do in the future to continue your project? What might you do differently next time?

## Tips For Making Your Video Great

- 1 Practice your presentation before you start filming.
- 2 Test your video and audio before you start filming.
- 3 If you can, find someone in your household who can help film you. That way you can focus on your presentation.
- 4 Prepare some props that you can use for your presentation.
- 5 Try to look at the camera when you are speaking.
- 6 Speak slowly and clearly. It helps to speak slower than you normally would.
- 7 Don't wear clothes with busy patterns. Solid colours are best.
- 8 Watch your video after you are finished. Make sure you're happy with it before you submit.
